WiFi Info

WSU provides secure wireless Internet for our event. To connect follow the instructions below. If you have trouble, find a committee member or volunteer for help. Committee members will have yellow name tags and volunteers will have red.

1. In your Wireless Network Connection list select "**WSU Secure**"
2. When prompted for a network username and password input:
Username: KLF
Password: KSLinux2017
3. Click [Okay] and connect to the WSU Secure wireless network.
4. Please make sure you are using DHCP to gain a valid IP address.

NOTE 1: While many systems will pick the correct wireless security settings, some may need to be manually configured to login.

The required security settings for "**WSU Secure**" are:

Security: WPA2 Enterprise
Authentication: Protected EAP (PEAP)
CA certificate (identity): None
PEAP version: Automatic
Inner authentication: MSCHAPv2

NOTE 2: You can access the "**WSU Guest**" wireless network on campus. However, this network has limited access, rate-limited bandwidth, and only allows access to ports 80/443 (http/https).
